Program: Briefing Session on New Life as Postgraduates

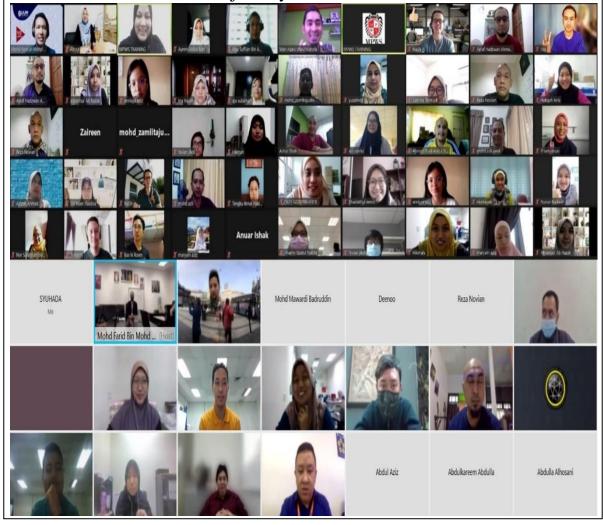

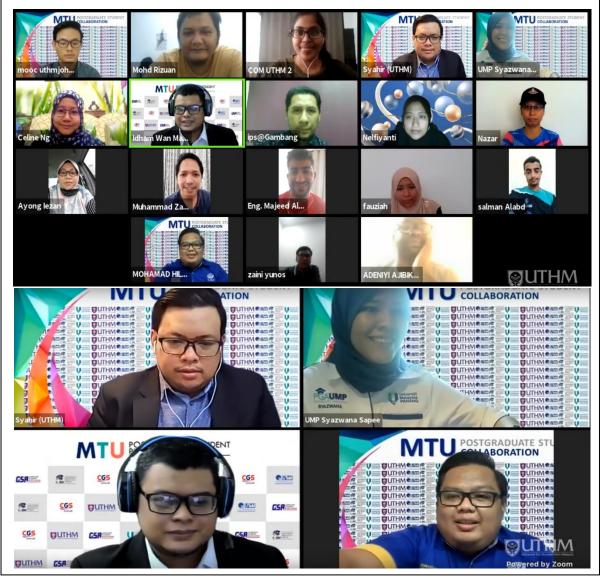
Program: MTUN Postgraduate Student Collaboration
